ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the Northwest Lift Station and Force Main project will be received by the City of Moscow Mills at the office of the City Clerk at Moscow Mills City Hall, 995 Main Street, Moscow Mills, Missouri 63362, until 3:00 P.M. local time on February 14, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The entire name of the project must appear on the outside of the bid envelope submitted to the City Clerk's office.

The Project consists of constructing the Northwest Lift Station and force main to transport wastewater flows to the Crooked Creek Wastewater Treatment Facility, and all necessary appurtenances.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 A.M. local time on January 23, 2019 at the Moscow Mills City Hall, 995 Main Street, Moscow Mills, MO 63362. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Financing for this project is through the Missouri State Revolving Fund, established by the sale of Missouri Water Pollution Control Bonds and Federal Capitalization Grants to Missouri.

The cost of printed Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office will depend on the number and size of the Drawings and Project Manual, applicable taxes, and shipping method selected by the prospective Bidder. Cost of Bidding Documents and shipping is non-refundable. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, printed Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of the Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall submit proof of qualifications to perform the Work as described in the Instructions to Bidders.
