P&Z's input for installing solar arrays for additional power

Dr. Schoedinger is providing information to the board, to see if this is worth him moving forward.

The solar "towers" that would be erected, are approximately 120 feet high, would provide much needed electric, as the Lab expand. These are environmentally friendly, cost approximately \$2 million each, and provide 250KW of electric. There will need to have a zoning variance.
