



6:00 p.m.-Mayor Flannigan calls the meeting to order. Steve Aston, Alderman Ward I; Tom Gormley, Alderman Ward I; Jerry Green, Alderman Ward II; and Cody Quist, Alderman Ward II are present. Also in attendance is Linda Haynes, City Clerk and Terry Foster, Chief of Police. There are no guests in attendance.

**In re: Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence**-Mayor Flannigan leads the Pledge of Allegiance and then a moment of silence is held.

**In re: Ordinance #1000-Use tax-providing for submission of the proposal to the qualified voters at the August 2, 2022 Primary Election**-Following a short discussion, Linda Haynes reads the title of Ordinance #1000 in full two times. Cody Quist makes a motion to approve Ordinance #1000. Jerry Green seconds the motion. Roll call vote is as follows: Steve Aston-Aye, Tom Gormley-Aye, Jerry Green-Aye, Cody Quist-Aye.

**In re: Update on Police Station Rehab**-Mayor Flannigan states that \$8,500 was included in the budget for new furniture for the Police Department. A list of the furniture Chief Foster is wanting to purchase is provided. Mayor Flannigan states that he does not need Board approval to move forward with the purchase, the furniture was approved in the budget. Chief Foster states that the list doesn't include shipping or assembly. Two desks and chairs are still needed for the squad room. Cody Quist suggests checking at Costco for office chairs. Tom Gormley suggests the use of fireproof file cabinets. Mayor Flannigan states that there should be money left out of the \$8,500, so \$2,000 of that is going to be used for low pile carpet, like is in the rest of the offices.

Cody Quist makes a motion to adjourn. Jerry Green seconds the motion. All are in favor.
