



6:00 p.m.-Mayor Flannigan calls the meeting to order. Steve Aston, Alderman Ward I; Tom Gormley, Alderman Ward I; Jerry Green, Alderman Ward II; and Cody Quist, Alderman Ward II are present. Also in attendance is Linda Haynes, City Clerk and Cindy Davenport, City Attorney. There are two guests in attendance.

In re: Pledge of Allegiance & Moment of Silence-Mayor Flannigan leads the Pledge of Allegiance and then a moment of silence is held.

In re: Ordinance #1022-Marijuana sales tax on ballot-There is a short discussion regarding the proposed ordinance and what surrounding communities are doing. Cindy Davenport states that "Proposition M" has been inserted into the ordinance that had been provided as the name for the ballot question, and that "non-medicinal" has been inserted before the word marijuana throughout the ordinance. Cindy Davenport reads the title of Ordinance #1022 in full two times. Cody Quist makes a motion to approve Ordinance #1022. Steve Aston seconds the motion. Roll call vote is as follows: Steve Aston-Aye, Tom Gormley-Aye, Jerry Green-Aye, Cody Quist-Aye.

Mayor Flannigan requests a motion to amend the agenda to discuss pay for the City Attorney to attend and be a part of the Comprehensive Plan task force. Cody Quist makes a motion to amend the agenda, Steve Aston seconds the motion. Roll call vote is as follows: Steve Aston-Aye, Tom Gormley-Nay, Jerry Green-Aye, Cody Quist-Aye.

In re: Comprehensive Plan task force-City Attorney's participation-Mayor Flannigan states that Cindy Davenport would like to be a part of the Comprehensive Plan task force. She has volunteered to participate at no cost to the City, but he would like to see her paid \$150 per meeting. Jerry Green makes a motion to approve the \$150 per meeting for the City Attorney attending the Comprehensive Plan task force meetings. Tom Gormley seconds the motion. All are in favor.

Tom Gormley makes a motion to adjourn. Steve Aston seconds the motion. All are in favor.
